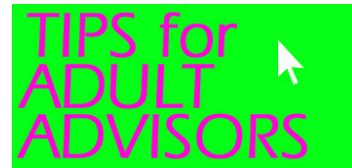


***Safety-Wise* Guidelines**



***Safety-Wise* and Beyond**

Issues like liability insurance and certified instructors are a concern when planning activities for girls. Beyond *Safety-Wise*, state and federal laws often require additional safety considerations. For example, many Girl Scout councils can only approve a provider for girl activities if they carry \$1 million in liability insurance.



When in Doubt...

Consult with the staff at your Girl Scout council whenever you have a concern about following *Safety-Wise* guidelines. Find out what parameters will make certain activities acceptable. They may have a list of approved providers in your area (for activities like rock climbing, whitewater rafting, horse stables, high ropes courses, and surfing schools). Inquire about other volunteers who might have more expertise with an activity (in an IP or proposed by a girl for her own goal).
